CONFERENCE CENTER RULES

This camp is a place set apart unto God. As such, we desire that everything that happens at this camp be to the glory of our Lord and Savior. To this end, violations of absolutes stated below will result in the camper being asked to leave immediately.

"All things are lawful for me, but all things are not helpful. All things are lawful for me, but I will not be brought under the power of any. The following Absolutes are cause for immediate removal from the camp. In extreme cases we may call local law enforcement as well." I Cor. 6:12

CAMP ABSOLUTES

- NO DRUGS · NO ALCOHOL · NO SMOKING · NO VULGAR LANGUAGE
- NO FIRE OF ANY KIND · NO VIOLENCE OR FIGHTING OR THREATS OF THE SAME
- NO WEAPONS OF ANY KIND
- NO MEN ALLOWED TO VISIT ON CAMPUS DURING WOMEN'S RETREATS
- NO WOMEN ALLOWED TO VISIT ON CAMPUS DURING MEN'S RETREATS
- NO PRACTICAL JOKES · NO STEALING
- NO DESTRUCTION OF CAMP PROPERTY
- NO EXPOSED SKIN EXCEPT AT THE POOL · NO TAGGING OR GRAFFITI

FACILITY RULES

1. No moving of the furniture.
2. No jumping on beds.
3. No moving the mattresses out on to the decks of the buildings.
4. No skateboards or inline skates.
5. No Bikes in the buildings or on the decks and walkways.
6. No skis or snowboards in the dorms.
7. Pick up all trash created by your group.
8. All balls and game equipment must be checked out in the snack bar.
9. Do not cut trails and switchbacks.
10. Fires in the lodge are only for the nighttime hours
11. No not park anywhere that is not marked as a parking stall
12. Once the camp is in progress driving is only for delivery or the handicapped.
13. Stay away from all of the private residences.
14. Departure times are to be strictly adhered to so as to expedite housekeeping.
15. No hikes after the conference has ended.
16. No yelling, screaming or other loud noise after 10:00 PM.
17. Curfew is 11:30 PM [unless prior arrangements have been made].
18. The kitchen is off limits to everyone except camp staff.
19. No food or drinks in any building if the Camp does not serve food in that building.
20. Do not feed the bears, antagonize the bears or take flash photos of them.
21. Watch your step as we do have rattlesnakes in the area.
22. Report all mountain lion sightings to staff immediately.
23. All items to be offered for sale on the grounds must be approved by the Director.
24. No secular music is to be played on camp property unless approved by the Director.
25. No offensive bumper sticker on cars left on grounds.
26. The Camp Director has the final authority in all matter on Camp property, and we thereby reserve the right to remove or deny access to anyone.

DRESS CODE

We request that the dress of those in the camp be modest, in good taste and should not draw attention to oneself. As a result, we do not allow two piece bathing suits to be worn by our female guests. If a two piece bathing suit is all you have, please wear a T-shirt or similar cover up. In addition, both men and women must wear a shirt and shorts or pants when coming to and from the pool.

1. No exposed undergarments. Ladies must wear appropriate undergarments.
2. No short shorts, legs must be at least 3" long.
3. No spaghetti strap blouses (Tank Tops should be modest).
4. No bare midsections or see-through clothing.
5. Shoes must be worn at all times except at the pool.
6. No gang style clothing.
7. Guys must wear shirts at all times.
8. No hair dying while at camp.
9. No T-shirts are allowed with offensive materials i.e. beer, drugs, sexual innuendos, etc.

WINTER

1. Do not use the snow play areas without camp staff present.
2. Stay out of the way of all snow removal equipment. We can't always see you.
3. Do not throw snowballs at buildings.
4. Do not throw snowballs at anyone who does not want to be hit.
5. The trash bags in the dorms are not to be used as sleds.
6. Do not play with or eat the icicles.

ITEMS TO BRING

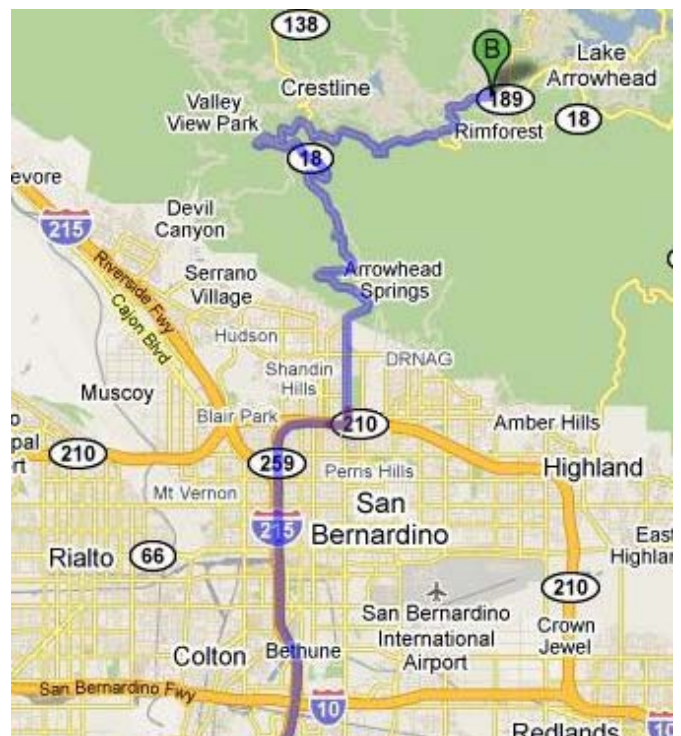

4. Take the CA-18/WATERMAN AVENUE exit
5. Follow Waterman Avenue up the mountain
(approximately 30 minutes) to Lake Gregory Drive
6. Turn left on Lake Gregory and make an
IMMEDIATE right onto Hwy 189
7. Follow Hwy 189 through Twin Peaks to the Conference
Center located on the South (right) side of the street
