

ABOUT PASTOR STEVE WRIGHT

Pastor Steve has been serving the Lord in a variety of pastoral-teaching ministries since 1995. These include the leading of Sunday Services at Sunflower Gardens Nursing Home in Santa Ana (1995-2000), teaching various classes at Calvary Chapel of Costa Mesa (1997-1999), and hosting and teaching a home Bible study that eventually became a Sunday church fellowship in Orange (1996-2004). He has been an ordained Calvary Chapel pastor since 1998.

In addition to Southern California, the Lord has used Steve on two different mission trips to India (1998-1999), where he ministered among the blind, lepers, and orphans, but also was able to instruct young pastors in the Scriptures, in addition to speaking at many churches.

Upon moving to the Lake Elsinore area, Steve continued to minister within a local church, leading both a married couples fellowship and college/career Bible study, until the Lord directed his path to Calvary Chapel Lake Elsinore in September of 2006. In the summer of 2007, he began teaching the Wednesday midweek study.
